



Maintenance Schedule for GRANWOOD and GRANSPRUNG Sports & Multi-Use Floors

Please note that the following recommendations are for guidance only and the cleaning programme should be influenced by the type and intensity of the floor usage.

It is recommended that provision is made for the installation of adequate dirt control matting in entranceways, which will ensure the prevention of as much grit and other abrasive materials as possible from being deposited on the floor.

Daily Cleaning

Sweep with 'V' Mopsweepers or push-mops dampened with 1:4 solution of **SPORTSCLEAN** to collect dirt and other abrasive materials. The use of sweeping compounds should be avoided.

Weekly /Monthly Cleaning

It is strongly recommended that Granwood and Gransprung floors be maintained with automatic scrubber/dryer machines using **SPORTSCLEAN** or **LOW FOAM SWIFT**, following the dilution rates shown on the container. Should a 'conventional' system be used for regular cleaning, i.e. mop, bucket and rotary machine, etc., it is suggested that a 'workable' area is mopped down with cleaning solution, scrubbed with the machine and then wet-vacuumed dry. Do not allow the cleaning solution to remain on the surface for an excessive amount of time before removal (i.e. no longer than 15-20 minutes)

SPORTSCLEAN should be used for regular cleaning of the sports floor, thereby maintaining good surface traction.

LOW FOAM SWIFT should be used for particularly dirty floors or cleaning operations following functions at which outdoor shoes have been worn.

EZEE BLACK MARK REMOVER should be used for 'spot cleaning' stubborn marks, such as scuff marks from outdoor shoes.

PLEASE NOTE: In the case of Gransprung installations, great care must be taken to ensure water or cleaning solutions are not allowed to penetrate beneath the surface. It is therefore strongly recommended that when using a scrubber/dryer or conventional cleaning system, scrubbing is only carried out up to a 'border' of approximately 30cm from the edge of the floor. This 'border' may then be damp mopped, thereby avoiding the risk of possible damage to the floor by water penetration.

PLEASE NOTE: POLISH/DRESSING OR POLYMER BASED MAINTAINERS SHOULD NOT BE USED ON FLOORS WHERE ANY SPORTING ACTIVITIES TAKE PLACE

Periodic Maintenance

After a period of time, your floor will require recoating with Granguard (manufactured by Granwax) in order to restore the original appearance, restore optimum traction and offer protection to the surface. Please refer to the relevant Granwood floor recoating procedure instructions before undertaking this work. Alternatively, you may contact us for specialist advice or to obtain a quote for refurbishment work by Granwood Contracts Department.

Following refurbishment of the floor, the sport hall can be re-opened to light traffic 60 hours after the final coat has been applied. The Granguard will continue to cure for up to seven days after final coat application. Full activities may then be resumed. The use of cleaning chemicals/machines must be avoided until the Granguard is fully cured.
